

Autism Education Training: Early Years – Tiers 1 / 2 / 3

Ashmount School, Loughborough

Autism affects around 1 in 100 children and adults. All professionals working in early years education settings should be prepared to support children on the autistic spectrum, and all staff should have a basic awareness of autism and the needs of individual children.

This training, delivered by Leicestershire Autism Outreach Service, is designed for use across all types of early years settings and all levels of children's ability up to the age of five years. All materials have been developed in consultation with staff, training providers, individuals on the autistic spectrum, parents and carers.

Tier 1 – Making sense of autism

Tier 2 – Developing good autism practice

Tier 3 – Leading Good Practice

For all staff who need further knowledge about autism and/or who train or lead other staff in their setting, for example SENCOs or managers.
