<p>A: 9.30- 12.00</p>	<p>Read, Write, Count – ensuring challenge within continuous provision.</p> <p>Guiding and supporting children’s early Literacy and Mathematical development is a skilful process which we will examine in depth during this practical session. There will be lots to explore- inspiring book areas, writing areas to nurture confidence and purpose, and maths areas rich in mathematical language and discussion. A challenge we face is how to keep pace with the ever-changing technological world, whilst ensuring other areas of children’s learning are not overlooked.</p> <p>This twilight will encourage participants to take a fresh look at the world of technology in early years, consider how to successfully integrate it within the environment and use it as a purposeful tool. During the session we will be discussing what the key skills are relating to technology that children need to master. <p>A: 9.30- 12.00</p>	<p>Mixing It Up! Addressing the Challenges of Teaching in Reception/Year 1</p> <p>Teaching within a mixed Reception/ Year One class provides a range of challenges. Teachers can often feel stretched between two different key stages. In this session we will discuss and explore how we can provide developmentally appropriate learning opportunities for all of the children and what challenge looks like within the context of a mixed age class. Maximising the potential of the space you have needs careful planning and preparation so that it is both inspiring and engaging and can successfully meet the needs of the Y1 curriculum. This twilight will explore how to offer valuable experiences that contribute to all areas of learning and development; including providing opportunities to extend children's maths, literacy, problem solving and thinking skills.
