

Mathematical Reasoning

Take part in dynamic and physical activities to help gain an understanding of how children see maths and embed enriching learning experiences through their school.

Who should attend?

This course, suitable for Primary Staff, is aimed at NQTs, RQTs, Class Teachers, Teaching Assistants, Subject / Key Stage Coordinators or Leaders and Senior Leaders.

What is it?

This course will promote and improve your children's confidence in and skills of reasoning and communication in mathematics.

You will explore how language and dialogue support the negotiation of meaning and understand the importance of reasoning mathematically within the new curriculum.

Lastly, consider ways of developing and challenging pupils' reasoning skills.

What will I do?

Study why we need reasoning to be a fluent skill that permeates all teaching and learning in mathematics and understand exactly what reasoning is from EYFS to Y6.

This hands-on session using various approaches will give you the opportunity to empathise with learners by actually tackling activities, how to refine pupils' thinking in order to explain their reasoning and how pupils should be responding to the reasoning of others and re-evaluate their own thinking to accommodate new ideas.

The course also shows how we can promote a shared understanding with others through exploring areas of disagreement, confusion or new examples.
