

Paediatric First Aid Level 3

The Level 3 Award in Paediatric First Aid qualification is ideal for those who work or intend to work in a childcare setting as it is been specifically designed to fulfil Ofsted's first aid requirements for early years teachers, nursery workers and childminders. All newly qualified entrants to the early years' workforce with a level 2 or 3 qualification must also have the full (2 day) 12 hour Paediatric First Aid certificate within 3 months of starting work.

Who should attend?

This course is for all Early Years' providers in England (from 3 April 2017) including maintained schools, non-maintained schools, independent schools, all providers on the Early Years Register and all providers registered with an early year's childminder agency.

Course content

Below are some of the topics you will cover:

- Paediatric Emergency First Aid
 - Be able to assess an emergency situation and prioritise what action to take
 - Help a baby or child who is unresponsive and breathing normally
 - Help a baby or child who is unresponsive and not breathing normally
 - Help a baby or child who is having a seizure
 - Help a baby or child who is choking
- Managing Paediatric Illness and Injury
 - Help a baby or child who is suffering from anaphylactic shock
 - Help a baby or child who has had an electric shock
 - Help a baby or child who has burns or scalds

Certification

Successful candidates will be awarded a certificate valid for 3 years.
