

Specific Learning Difficulties

Dyslexia, Dyscalculia and Dysgraphia

This one day course will provide you with an overview of 3 common specific learning difficulties (SpLDs) allowing you to increase your awareness in the classroom.

Who should attend?

This course is aimed at new SENCo's, Newly Qualified Teachers and Teachers and Teaching Assistants that have an SEN pupil in their class for the first time.

Objectives

- Deepen understanding of common SpLDs – their similarities and differences
- Be able to spot the signs and signals which help you to respond and better meet children's needs
- Promote confidence in working with children with additional needs and supporting them to succeed
- Explore typical development of literacy and numeracy skills
- Look at differences that arise due to the learning needs
- Explore the impact of SpLDs on acquisition of literacy and numeracy skills
- Identify a range of practical strategies that work to support children and promote inclusion.
