Getting classroom and behaviour management right is the key to a successful learning environment. This course will focus on establishing rules, routines and relationships that enable you to focus on teaching and learning.

Who should attend?

This course would be particularly suitable for NQTs and RQTs but also for any teachers wanting to revisit this key theme and to gain some new ideas and strategies.

Course content

The session will cover a range of themes and ideas including:

- Engaging students
- Key strategies for Behaviour Management
- Low level disruption - How to deal with it
- Diffusing major confrontations
- Developing relationships
- Getting quiet in the classroom
- Setting out good rules, routines and expectations
- Using rewards, consequences and sanctions to best effect
