

Team Teach Training for school leaders, teachers and support staff.

Training is carried out by Advanced Team Teach Trainers.

Courses include all course materials, certification, lunch and refreshments.

Courses on offer:

- **BASIC COURSE(2 days)** for staff with no previous TT training or those who no longer have a valid basic certificate. This training is aimed at staff who encounter pupils who present more challenging behaviour and includes the teaching of restrictive physical intervention techniques (training to be renewed within 24 months by completing the basic refresher course).
- **BASIC REFRESHER (1 day)** for those wanting to renew a valid certificate having previously completed the 12 hour basic course (This course should be repeated every 24 months as a refresher).
- **LOW RISK COURSE (1 day)** – a foundation course aimed at nurseries and mainstream schools dealing with low level challenging behaviour where minimal restrictive physical intervention is needed. (This course should be repeated every 36 months as a refresher).
- All courses are approved for training in Academy and LA Schools
